SimMan and SimBaby

The centre has both SimMan and SimBaby. Both have a realistic cardio-pulmonary system, palpable radial, brachial, carotid, and femoral pulses, audible heart and lung sounds and the capacity for:

Airway instrumentation, intubation, ventilation.

Physiological responses to medications and fluids.

Needle cricothyrotomy, chest tube placement.

IV insertion and urine output.

Chest compression and defibrillation

Programmable medical conditions.

Challenging scenarios allow participants to experience state-of-the-art medical training without risk to patients.

The Clinical Skills and Simulation Centre also offers training on Basic Life Support, and First Aid training specially tailored to meet individual groups such as youth groups, nursing homes and local businesses. Please contact Julie Turner (Clinical Skills Lead) to discuss this option.

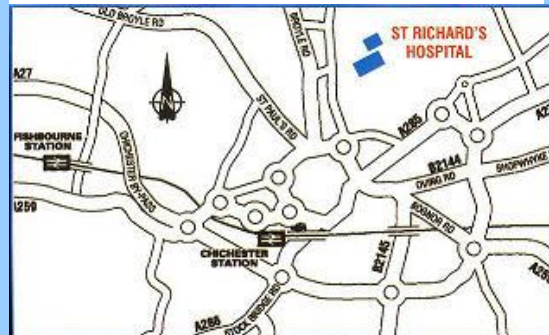
The centre also comprises state of the art audio-visual equipment and video conferencing facilities, which can be linked to the trusts
